PROGRAM SUMMARY

WHAT IS THE RIDER SUPPORT PROGRAM?

As the AUSX Championship grows to new locations, the AUSX Rider Support Program is designed to make competing in the 2026 AUSX Championship easier for riders and teams.

A major component included within this is a freight program. Instead of organising transport for your bike and equipment between rounds, AUSX will manage the freight logistics for you. Riders simply need to travel themselves to each event while AUSX handles the movement of bikes and equipment throughout the championship.

DETAILS

WHATS INCLUDED:

The Rider Support Program includes:

- ✓ Rider Series Entry
- ✓ 4 x Series Passes (including rider)
- ✓ Access to group accommodation rates
- ✓ Access to AUSX marketing material for sponsorship
- ✓ Access to AUSX content reward program
- ✓ AUSX-managed end-to-end freight service for all rounds
- ✓ Secure transport crate supplied by AUSX
- ✓ Centralised logistics management
- ✓ Covered pit area at all long-haul event locations
- ✓ Shared bike wash facilities
- ✓ Shared workshop area with tools and equipment
- ✓ Fuel station infrastructure

WHAT YOU'LL NEED TO DO:

Riders are responsible for:

- Delivering equipment to the designated freight collection point
- Packing their bike and equipment
- Ensuring bikes are clean and compliant for transport
- Source fuel, oil and consumables locally for each event
- Arranging travel and accommodation for themselves and their team

HOW IT WILL WORK:

- Upon signing up to the program, you will be provided with the inclusions listed above
- Each rider will drop their bike and equipment at a designated location where it will be labelled and securely loaded into crates
- Freight will travel to each round and be placed by AUSX staff into designated locations for the riders arrival
- Riders will make travel plans with access to group booking discounts
- Riders will travel to each event and have access to their bike and equipment both pre and post each event for a designated period
- At the final round of the season, riders will collect their bike and equipment

FREIGHT

CRATES

- Crates will be provided by AUSX and shared between two riders.
- Dimensions: 1000mm W x 1200mm H x 2200mm L
- Max Weight of Contents: 220KG (per rider)

EQUIPMENT LOADING

- Crates will be loaded pre-season at depot locations based in Melbourne, Sydney and Brisbane.
- Riders will pre-register a loading location with AUSX and our team will support you to initially load your equipment
- Crates will be labelled and securely transported to each event

HANDLING

- On arrival, the crates will be placed to a pit allocation, where crates will be available to teams and riders for the event period.

EQUIPMENT AVAILABILITY

- Your bike will be available during each event period for maintenance but will not be accessible while freight is travelling between rounds. A full schedule of availability is provided.

INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORT

- As equipment will travel internationally between Australia and New Zealand, all bikes and equipment must be thoroughly cleaned and comply with freight and customs requirements.

SHARED FACILITIES

- AUSX will provide a range of shared workshop and event support facilities to reduce the amount of equipment riders need to transport.

CONTENTS

WHAT TO PACK

Crate contents must not weigh more than 220kgs in total per rider (440kgs per crate excluding the crate itself).

Below are indicative items which could fit within this space/weight.

WHAT NOT TO PACK

- Certain items such as fuel, oil, dangerous goods and large workshop equipment cannot be transported.
- A complete equipment inventory will be listed in the detailed guide of provided workshop items

FURTHER SUPPORT

TRAVEL SUPPORT

AUSX has secured accommodation partners across all event locations to provide access to discounted rates for teams and riders who sign up to the program.

RIDER ENTRIES

As part of the Rider Support Program, AUSX will pass on a 15% discount on entry fees. The inclusion with entry fees will also increase to 4 series passes (including rider).

SPONSORSHIP SUPPORT

As part of signing up to the Rider Support Program, AUSX will provide riders with access to marketing material to assist in raising sponsorship funding to support their series participation

RACER CONTENT REWARD PROGRAM

As part of the Rider Support Program, AUSX will be rewarding riders who proactively take steps to impact the series. AUSX will provide riders with access to a social media incentive payment structure where AUSX will make available \$100k in potential earnings across the series for riders producing content that generates engagement for the series.

In addition to this, AUSX will host social media and sponsorship seminars to support continued focus and education in this area.
